## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three.

### AN ACT REQUIRING OUT-OF-STATE MOTORISTS TO CARRY STATUTORY INSURANCE COVERAGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The first sentence of section 3 of chapter 90 of the General  
2 Laws, as amended by section 2 of chapter 463 of the acts of  
3 1953, is hereby further amended by inserting after the word  
4 "thirty-four A", in line 27, the words: — and a policy of  
5 liability insurance providing indemnity for protection to him  
6 and any person responsible for the operation of such motor  
7 vehicle or trailer with his express or implied consent against  
8 loss by reason of his liability to pay damages to others for  
9 damage caused to property real or personal at least to the  
10 amount of five thousand dollars.
