AN ACT RELATIVE TO APPOINTMENT OF ASSESSORS IN CERTAIN CITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, assessors in
2 cities under Plan A who are appointed shall be appointed by
3 the mayor subject to confirmation by a two thirds vote of the
4 city council.
