AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ADJUSTMENT OF THE MILEAGE ALLOWANCE FOR STATE EMPLOYEES OPERATING THEIR OWN AUTOMOBILES ON OFFICIAL BUSINESS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The allowance to state employees for expenses incurred by
- 2 them in the operation of motor vehicles owned by them and used
- 3 in the performance of their official duties shall be not less than
- 4 sixteen cents per mile.
