PROPOSAL FOR A LEGISLATIVE AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION PROVIDING THAT THE MASSACHUSETTS PORT AUTHORITY AND THE MASSACHUSETTS TURNPIKE AUTHORITY BE REQUIRED TO PAY TAXES ON ALL PROPERTY LOCATED IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

1 A majority of all the members elected to the Senate and House  
2 of Representatives, in joint session, hereby declares it to be  
3 expedient to alter the Constitution by the adoption of the  
4 following Article of Amendment, to the end that it may become  
5 a part of the Constitution [if similarly agreed to in a joint session  
6 of the next General Court and approved by the people at the  
7 state election next following]:

8 ARTICLE OF AMENDMENT.

9 All properties owned and/or operated by the Massachusetts  
10 Port Authority and the Massachusetts Turnpike Authority are  
11 hereby required to pay full tax value on said properties to the  
12 city of Boston.

By the House of Representatives, in the Senate Chamber, at the City of Washington, this 1st day of March, 1878.

The Constitution of the United States

Article I. Section 1.

All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Representatives and direct Taxes shall be apportioned among the several States which may be admitted to or separated from the Union, according to their respective Numbers, which shall be determined by adding to the whole Number of free Persons, including those bound to Service for a Year, and excluding Indians not taxed, three fifths of all other Persons.

ARTICLE OF AMENDMENT

1. All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.
