AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO EXPEDITE THE VACATING OF THE QUARTERS OF THE PRESENT QUINSIGAMOND COMMUNITY COLLEGE ON BELMONT STREET IN THE CITY OF WORCESTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The department of education is hereby authorized and
- 2 directed to expedite the vacating of the quarters of the present
- 3 Quinsigamond Community College presently leased from the city
- 4 of Worcester on Belmont Street. Said department shall, upon the
- 5 vacating of said quarters, establish therein courses for vocational
- 6 education, with a specific area maintained for the occupational
- 7 training of mentally retarded children.
