AN ACT PERMITTING THE TRANSFER OF A HAWKER AND PEDDLER'S LICENSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 101 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 24 the following section: —

3 *Section 24A.* A license granted under section twenty-two
4 may be transferred by the director, upon application therefor,
5 accompanied by a fee of two dollars and upon evidence
6 furnished by the applicant like that required for the original
7 granting of such license.
