AN ACT TO PREVENT INTERRUPTION OF HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFITS OF STATE EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 10 of G.L. chapter 32A is hereby amended by
2 inserting the following sentence between the first and second
3 sentences of the last paragraph of said section 10:

4 "Except that, in the case of health insurance, the employee
5 shall be offered the option of maintaining membership in the
6 group health insurance plan, provided that he pay the full cost
7 of the premium in effect and an administrative fee not to
8 exceed 1% of the premium."
