## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three.

### AN ACT GRANTING AN EXEMPTION TO DEAF PERSONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph 5 of section 1 of chapter 60A of the  
2 General Laws is hereby amended by inserting the following  
3 words: "or permanent total loss of hearing certified by the  
4 Veterans Administration" after the words: "or permanent loss of  
5 use of, one or both hands" in line 5 of said paragraph.

1 SECTION 2. Paragraph 5 of section 1 of chapter 60A of the  
2 General Laws is hereby further amended by inserting the  
3 following words: "or permanent total loss of hearing medically  
4 certified" after the words: "both legs or both arms" in line 16 of  
5 said paragraph.
