Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 2 Laws, inserted by section 3 chapter 874 of the acts of 1971, is
- 3 hereby amended by inserting after the word "accommodations"
- 4 in lines 2 and 3, the words: "or mobile home park".
