AN ACT REQUIRING ALL GAS PIPES TO BE ONE COLOR.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

- 1 Chapter 164 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 73 the following section: —
- 3 *Section 73A.* All gas pipes shall be painted one color. This
- 4 responsibility shall be upon the local gas company when
- 5 installing pipes in a new structure. The owner of older
- 6 structures shall have this responsibility.
