**AN ACT MAKING CERTAIN FORMER INMATES ELIGIBLE FOR SURETY
AND PERFORMANCE BONDS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Commonwealth of Massachusetts by its Commissioner of
2 Corrections and through its Commissioner of Insurance may
3 provide performance and/or surety bonds to paroled or
4 released inmates from any correctional institution, house of
5 correction or jail in the Commonwealth in an amount not
6 greater than five thousand dollars. Said bond shall be issued
7 only if the Commissioner of Corrections, in writing, so requests
8 the Commissioner of Insurance to issue said bond. Granting of
9 any bond must, in the opinion of the Commissioner of
10 Corrections, be essential to the rehabilitation and self support
11 of the former inmate. Premiums of bonds granted shall be paid
12 by the person so bonded.
