### AN ACT TO UPGRADE THE JOB CLASSIFICATION OF CERTAIN ENGINEERS, ENGINEERING ADMINISTRATORS, RIGHT OF WAY ADMINISTRATORS, PLANNING ADMINISTRATORS AND SCIENTIFIC ADMINISTRATORS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The job groups of all engineers, engineering administrators,
- 2 right of way administrators, planning administrators and
- 3 scientific administrators presently in job group twenty-two (22)
- 4 through job group twenty-seven (27) inclusive in the classified
- 5 service of the Commonwealth is hereby increased by two job
- 6 groups at each of the seven steps on the general salary schedule.
