AN ACT RELATIVE TO FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR A CITY, TOWN OR DISTRICT IN THE REMODELING, RECONSTRUCTING, OR MAKING EXTRAORDINARY REPAIRS TO PUBLIC BUILDINGS AND OTHER PUBLIC FACILITIES OWNED BY THE CITY, TOWN OR DISTRICT WHEN SUCH CITY, TOWN OR DISTRICT IS COMPELLED TO MAKE SUCH CHANGES UNDER A LAW OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary when
2 a city, town or district is compelled by a law of the common-
3 wealth to remodel, reconstruct or make extraordinary repairs
4 to public buildings and other public facilities owned by the
5 city, town or district, all costs and expenses of this project as
6 may be approved by the emergency finance board established
7 under section one of chapter forty-nine of the acts of nineteen
8 hundred and thirty-three shall be assumed by the common-
9 wealth.
