## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three.

AN ACT DECREASING THE AGE AT WHICH CERTAIN ELDERLY PERSONS WOULD BE ENTITLED TO EXEMPTIONS FROM REAL ESTATE TAXES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Clause forty-first of section 5 of chapter 59 of the General
- 2 Laws, as appearing in chapter 456 of the acts of 1970, is
- 3 hereby amended by striking out, in lines 4 and 7, the word
- 4 "seventy" and inserting in place thereof, in each instance, the
- 5 words: — sixty-five.
