By Mr. Picucci of Leominster, petition of Angelo Picucci (with the approval of the mayor and city council) that the licensing board for the city of Leominster be authorized to issue a license for the sale of alcoholic beverages to the Gondola Restaurant Inc. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE LICENSING BOARD FOR THE CITY OF LEOMINSTER TO ISSUE A LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO THE GONDOLA RESTAURANT INC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any limitation on the number
2 of alcoholic beverage licenses which may be issued in the City
3 of Leominster under the provisions of section seventeen of
4 chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws, but
5 subject, however, to all other provisions of said chapter, the
6 licensing board of said city may issue a license for the sale of
7 alcoholic beverages under section twelve of said chapter one
8 hundred and thirty-eight to the Gondola Restaurant Inc.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
