AN ACT TO REPEAL THE "NO FAULT" AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 That portion of section 34A of chapter 90 of the General
- 2 Laws beginning with "Personal Injury Protection" and ending
- 3 with "(3) with the specific intent of causing injury or damage
- 4 to himself or others" is hereby repealed.
- 5 Section 34M of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby
- 6 repealed.
- 7 Section 34N of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby
- 8 repealed.
- 9 Section 6D of chapter 231 of the General Laws is hereby
- 10 repealed.
