RESOLVE FOR FURTHER INCREASING THE UTILITY OF AUTOMOBILES BY ENCOURAGING THE OPERATORS OF THEM TO BE CAREFUL AND FOREHANDED.

1 *Resolved*, That the General Court of Massachusetts respect-  
2 fully urges the Congress of the United States to apportion some  
3 of its "Revenue Sharing Funds" to each State in accord with  
4 progress made in each individual State in reducing death caused  
5 by automobiles upon the highways within each individual State.

6 *Resolved*, That a copy of these resolutions be sent forthwith  
7 by the Secretary of the Commonwealth to the President of the  
8 United States, to the presiding officer of each branch of Con-  
9 gress, to all members thereof from this Commonwealth, to all  
10 other members, to the principal library in each city and town of  
11 this Commonwealth and to the principal library in each high  
12 school and in each institution of higher learning in this Common-  
13 wealth.
