

By Mr. Aleixo of Taunton, petition of Theodore J. Aleixo, Jr. (with the approval of the mayor and city council) that the city of Taunton be authorized to pay former members of its police department certain sums of money awarded to them by arbitration. Local Affairs. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF TAUNTON TO PAY TO FORMER MEMBERS OF ITS POLICE DEPARTMENT CERTAIN SUMS OF MONEY AWARDED TO THEM BY AN ARBITRATOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the
2 contrary, the city of Taunton is hereby authorized to pay to two
3 former members of its police department, Henry Cardoza and
4 John Correia, the following sums of money awarded to them as a
5 result of an arbitration award rendered by an arbitrator pursuant
6 to a dispute which arose under a collective bargaining contract
7 between said city and the Taunton Police Association prior to
8 the year nineteen hundred and seventy-three: — Henry
9 Cardoza \$579.12, John Correia \$827.90

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
