Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The commissioner of insurance is hereby au-
2 thorized and directed to promulgate rules and regulations
3 directing insurers of motor vehicles who do not use brokers to
4 charge ten percent less on their insurance schedules.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of January first,
2 nineteen hundred and seventy-one.
