By Mr. Desrocher of Nantucket, petition of the Massachusetts Hospital Association that the Rate Setting Commission be prohibited from using Blue Cross auditors and accountants for the examination of the accounts and statistical records of hospitals. Insurance.

AN ACT PROHIBITING THE USE OF BLUE CROSS AUDITORS AND ACCOUNTANTS BY THE RATE SETTING COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 5 of chapter 176A, most recently amended by
2 chapter 874 of the acts of 1969, is hereby amended by adding
3 at the end of the last sentence of the eighth paragraph the
4 following sentence: —

5 The commission shall not enter into an agreement with Blue
6 Cross for the services of Blue Cross auditors and accountants,
7 to examine the books of account and statistical records of
8 hospitals.
