AN ACT FOR THE PRESERVATION OF MOUNT GREYLOCK RESERVATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 21 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 4G the following section:

3 *Section 4H.* Be it that the Mt. Greylock Reservation or any
4 future acquisition thereto—being considered a part of the
5 reservation—shall not be leased, sold, or returned to any private
6 individual, business agency, municipality, non-profit organiza-
7 tion, or quasi-public agency for any purpose whatsoever. Public
8 uses consisting of existing facilities for radio and television
9 communication; Bascom Lodge; the Veterans Memorial Park;
10 any building or facilities necessary to the operation of the
11 Reservation under the Department of Natural Resources; and,
12 in particular, watershed areas for neighboring communities to
13 provide for present and future needs, shall be construed as the
14 only acceptable uses within the reservation.
