AN ACT REQUIRING A HOUSING AUTHORITY TO BARGAIN COLLECTIVELY WITH LABOR ORGANIZATIONS REPRESENTING ITS EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:
