AN ACT ESTABLISHING WORK-STUDY OPPORTUNITIES FOR UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS IN STATE AND MUNICIPAL AGENCIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1D of Chapter 15 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by adding the following paragraph: —

3 The board shall allocate to approved institutions of higher
4 education within the commonwealth such funds as may be
5 appropriated for the purpose of providing work-study oppor-
6 tunities for students in a student work incentive program in state
7 and municipal human service agencies. The board shall establish
8 such regulations governing eligibility for an administration of
9 such work-study grants as it shall deem necessary, but shall take
10 into account in allocating funds to institutions, enrollments
11 levels, financial need of enrolled students, other resources
12 available to the institution, and previous student financial aid
13 efforts made by the institution, and shall include among its regu-
14 lations maximum weekly hours and minimum rates for students
15 assisted under this program. Each state or municipal agency
16 seeking to participate in said program shall file a student utiliza-
17 tion plan subject to the approval of the board. The board shall
18 establish, subject to the advice of the advisory committee, a plan
19 coordinating the financial aid officers of approved institutions of
20 higher learning and administrative officers of each state and
21 municipal agency so involved.
