AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CITIES AND TOWNS MAY BY A FOUR-FIFTHS VOTE REDUCE THE BUDGET OF A SCHOOL COMMITTEE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 34 of chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding the following paragraph: —
- 3 Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary contained in
- 4 this section, a city or town may, by a four-fifths vote of the
- 5 city council or by a four-fifths vote of a town meeting, as the
- 6 case may be, reduce or strike any item in the budget of the
- 7 school committee.
