**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three.

**AN ACT FURTHER PROTECTING CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF YOUTH SERVICES.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 66 of subsection 1 of chapter 18A of the General  
2 Laws is hereby amended by striking out the first paragraph of  
3 said section and inserting in place thereof the following new  
4 paragraph: —

5 All officers and employees of the division of youth service  
6 who immediately prior to July 1, 1973 hold positions classified  
7 under chapter thirty-one of the General Laws, or have tenure  
8 in their positions by reason of sections nine A, nine B and  
9 nine D of chapter thirty of the General Laws, shall continue to  
10 be employees of the department of youth services without  
11 impairment of civil service status, seniority, retirement and  
12 other employment rights, and without interruption of service  
13 within the meaning of said chapter thirty-one or said section  
14 nine A, nine B or nine D, and without reduction in compensa-  
15 tion and salary grade, notwithstanding any change in title or  
16 duties made under this act. All officers and employees of said  
17 division who immediately prior to July 1, 1973 do not hold  
18 positions classified under said chapter thirty-one, or do not have  
19 tenure in their positions by reason of said section nine A,  
20 nine B or nine D, shall continue to be employed in the  
21 department of youth services under this act without impair-  
22 ment of seniority retirement and other rights, and without  
23 interruption of service within the meaning of said section  
24 nine A, nine B or nine D, and said chapter thirty-one and  
25 without reduction in compensation and salary grade.
