By Mr. Pina of New Bedford, petition of Ronald A. Pina for legislation to provide for state reimbursement of seventy-five percent of the cost of constructing vocational schools and for the expansion of existing vocational schools. Education.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR STATE REIMBURSEMENT OF SEVENTY-FIVE PER CENT OF THE COST OF CONSTRUCTING VOCATIONAL SCHOOLS AND FOR THE EXPANSION OF EXISTING VOCATIONAL SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The commonwealth shall reimburse towns,
2 cities and regional school districts seventy-five per cent of the
3 cost of construction and expansion of vocational schools.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January 1, 1972
2 and shall apply to all projects approved on and after that date.

AS AMENDED FOR STATE REVISION IN SEVENTY TWO
THE FIRST OF THE BILL OF CONSTITUTIONAL
AMENDMENTS AND FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE
ARTICLE

It is enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the people,
that

SECTION 1. The committee shall continue until
the end of the year in which it was created
and shall report to the Legislature at the next
session of the Legislature

SECTION 2. The act shall take effect on January 1, 1973
and shall apply to all bills introduced on and after that date.
