AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE LICENSE FEE FOR NON-RESIDENT HUNTERS ON COMMERCIAL SHOOTING PRESERVES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The third paragraph of section 11 of chapter 131 of the
2 General Laws as most recently amended by chapter 706 of the
3 acts of 1972 is hereby further amended by striking in line eight
4 the words, "sixteen dollars and twenty-five cents" and inserting
5 in place thereof the words, "eight dollars and twenty-five
6 cents."
