In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three.

AN ACT INCREASING THE RETIREMENT PAY OF FIRE FIGHTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 To provide 50% of the current salary increases to retired fire
- 2 fighters. In the event of death of the retiree the sole surviving
- 3 spouse shall receive 50% of the prevailing increase.

The Constitution of the United States

Article I, Section 8, Clause 18

AN ACT TO ENFORCE THE PROVISIONS OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES IN RELATION TO THE TRADE AND COMMERCE OF THE UNITED STATES.

1. The President shall have the power to grant reprieves and pardons for offenses against the United States, except in cases of impeachment.
