AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE HOLDING OF PROMOTIONAL EXAMINATIONS IN THE DIVISION OF EMPLOYMENT SECURITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph B of section 13 of chapter 31 is hereby amended
2 by striking out the last two sentences of clause (2) of said
3 paragraph B, as most recently amended by section 3 of chapter
4 685 of the acts of 1971, and inserting in place thereof the
5 following three sentences:

6 All promotions in the official service of the division of
7 employment security in the department of labor and industries
8 shall be made in accordance with paragraph A or the provisions
9 of this clause; provided that for every promotion from a lower
10 to a higher grade in the official service of the division of
11 employment security in the department of labor and industries
12 subject to the examination provisions of clause (2) of this
13 paragraph, in every instance a promotional examination of the
14 kinds specified by clause (2) shall first be held. In the event
15 that such promotional examination fails to produce an eligible
16 list, an open competitive examination may, at the discretion of
17 the director, be held. The provisions of this clause at the
18 discretion of the director may be applied to any position in the
19 official service in any other department, and, so far as practica-
20 ble, to executive office promotional examinations, with the
21 approval of the secretary thereof and, to competitive promo-
22 tional examinations.
