AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE POWERS OF THE WOODS HOLE, MARTHA'S VINEYARD AND NANTUCKET STEAMSHIP AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 701 of the Acts of 1960 is hereby amended by insert-
2 ing after the next to the last paragraph the following new para-
3 graph:
4 "If new bonds issued by the Authority, the proceeds of which
5 are used for the purchase of new vessels or assets related thereto,
6 then the Authority shall be required to license any vessel having a
7 passenger capacity exceeding 45 persons or carrying freight for
8 hire in connection with its service to and from the areas of the
9 mainland to the Islands of Martha's Vineyard and Nantucket
10 providing that such vessel has not been operating as aforesaid
11 prior to the issuance of such bonds."
