The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three.

AN ACT REGULATING SHIPMENT OF MERCHANDISE TO WHOLESALERS OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 18 of Chapter 138 of the General Laws as amended is
- 2 hereby further amended by adding after the last paragraph there-
- 3 of the following new paragraph: —
- 4 All merchandise purchased by any licensee under this section,
- 5 and all merchandise shipped into this Commonwealth pursuant
- 6 to any purchase, must be warehoused at the warehouse facilities
- 7 of such licensee and held in his physical possession at such ware-
- 8 house prior to reshipment to other licensees under this chapter.
