## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three.

AN ACT PERMITTING LOCAL RETIREMENT BOARDS THE SAME LATITUDE OF INVESTMENT AS IS PERMITTED THE COMMONWEALTH RETIREMENT BOARD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Part D of subparagraph I of paragraph b of subdivision 2 of  
2 section 23 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as most recently  
3 amended by section 2 of chapter 343 of the acts of 1972, is  
4 hereby amended by striking out the word "ten" in the first line  
5 and substituting in place thereof the word: – fifteen.
