## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR LIMITED EXPENDITURES OF FUNDS BY SCHOOL COMMITTEES FOR THE EMPLOYMENT OF AN ARCHITECTURAL CONSULTANT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 inserting after section 37H the following section: —  
3 *Section 37-I.* The school committee of a city or town may  
4 employ an architect as an architectural consultant for the  
5 general purposes of the committee, and may expend money  
6 therefor from the funds appropriated by said city or town for  
7 school purposes, provided however, not more than ten thou-  
8 sand dollars shall be expended during any fiscal year without  
9 the prior approval of the mayor, the city manager in a city  
10 having Plan D or Plan E form of government, or the board of  
11 selectmen. Said architectural consultant shall not be subject to  
12 the provisions of section nine A of chapter thirty or the  
13 provisions of chapter thirty-one.
