AN ACT PROVIDING ADDITIONAL PUNISHMENT FOR CERTAIN PERSONS GIVING CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES TO PRISONERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 94C of the General Laws, as appearing in section 1
2 of chapter 1071 of the acts of 1971, is hereby amended by
3 inserting after section 32 the following section: —

4 *Section 32A.* In addition to the punishment provided in
5 section thirty-two, any person unlawfully giving any of the
6 controlled substances designated in section thirty-one to a per-
7 son confined in a house of correction or a state prison shall be
8 punished by imprisonment in a state prison for not less than
9 two and a half years and not more than five years.
