AN ACT TO REQUIRE MONITORS ON SCHOOL BUSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Section 7B of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most re-
2 cently amended by chapter 803 of the acts of 1971, is hereby
3 further amended by adding after clause (8) the following
4 clause: —

5 (9) Each school bus shall carry as a passenger at least one
6 person, eighteen years of age or over, who shall assist in main-
7 tenance of order and safety.
