By Mr. Cahill of Salem, petition of Robert E. Cahill and another that the Department of Public Works be authorized to pay a differential of ten percent for work performed during the nighttime hours. Public Service.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO PAY A TEN PER CENT WORK SHIFT DIFFERENTIAL PREMIUM FOR WORK PERFORMED BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 5:00 P.M. TO 7:00 A.M. DURING THE NORMAL TOUR OF DUTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph 6 of section 45 of chapter 30 of the General Laws
2 is hereby amended by adding at the end of said paragraph 6
3 the following: —

4 An employee of the commonwealth, department of public
5 works, who is assigned an evening tour of duty or a night tour
6 of duty, as defined in the rules and regulations, shall receive in
7 addition to the salary to which he/she is otherwise entitled a
8 differential of ten per cent of hours worked while so assigned.

By the Committee on the Judiciary, in response to a resolution of the House of Representatives, passed July 1, 1904, relating to the proposed amendments to the Constitution of the United States.

SECTION 1.
