In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT A CERTAIN PHYSICAL CONDITION OR DISEASE RESULTING IN TOTAL OR PARTIAL DISABILITY OR DEATH TO INVESTIGATORS OF THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES CONTROL COMMISSION SHALL BE PRESUMED TO HAVE BEEN SUFFERED IN LINE OF DUTY, WITH REFERENCE TO THE ACCIDENTAL DISABILITY RETIREMENT LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 94 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after the word "Airport", in line 16, as
3 appearing in chapter 610 of the acts of 1963, the words: – or
4 investigators of the alcoholic beverages control commission.
