AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE REDETERMINATION OF THE EQUALIZED VALUATION OF THE CITY OF LYNN.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to correct an inequity in the equal-
3 ized valuation of the city of Lynn, therefore it is hereby declared
4 an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of
5 the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The state tax commission shall within thirty days of the
2 passage of this act redetermine the equalized valuation esta-
3 blished for the city of Lynn in the year nineteen hundred and
4 seventy-two and shall give said city written notice of a proposed
5 equalized valuation as so redetermined. If said city is aggrieved
6 by such redetermination it may appeal to the appellate tax board
7 within sixty days of the receipt of such notice and the provisions
8 of section ten B of chapter fifty-eight of the General Laws shall
9 apply to such appeal. If the equalized valuation as redetermined
10 varies from such valuation established in the year nineteen hun-
11 dred and seventy-two, the commission shall recompute the final
12 equalization and apportionment established under section ten C
13 of said chapter fifty-eight and shall report the same to the general
14 court.
