AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO ERECT ADEQUATE SIGNS ALONG THE STATE HIGHWAYS TO MAKE KNOWN TO THE TRAVELING PUBLIC THE AVAILABILITY OF CAMPING FACILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The department of public works is hereby authorized and
- 2 directed to erect throughout its system of state highways
- 3 adequate signs to make known to the traveling public the
- 4 availability of camping facilities.
