### **AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING HORSE RACING MEETINGS.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Sub-section (5) of section 3 of chapter 128A of the General
- 2 Laws is hereby amended by striking out clause (h) and inserting
- 3 in place thereof the following clause: --
- 4 (h) No licenses shall be issued to permit running horse race
- 5 meetings to be held or conducted, except in connection with a
- 6 state or county fair, at the same time at more than one race
- 7 track within the county or within twenty-five miles of another
- 8 horse race tract at the same time, nor at any time at more than
- 9 two race tracks within the commonwealth.
