AN ACT REGULATING MUFFLERS FOR MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 7-O, the following section: —

3 *Section 7P.* No person shall service, install, sell, offer, ex-
4 pose for sale or have in his possession with intent to sell or
5 give away a muffler or muffler system which does not meet
6 standards and specifications set out by the registrar. The
7 registrar shall adopt standards and specifications for muffler
8 systems and such rules and regulations as he may deem
9 necessary to carry out the provisions of this section. Any
10 person who violates the provisions of this section shall be
11 punished by a fine of not less than twenty nor more than one
12 hundred dollars.
