By Mr. O'Leary of Holyoke, petition of James E. O'Leary that members of the teachers' retirement system be credited with time served as nursery school teachers for retirement purposes. Public Service.

AN ACT GIVING MEMBERS OF THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR CERTAIN YEARS OF SERVICE AS A NURSERY SCHOOL TEACHER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, a
2 member of the teachers' retirement system shall be given
3 creditable service for any years during the period from nineteen
4 hundred and thirty-four and nineteen hundred and forty-six
5 that such member served as a nursery school teacher provided
6 that the member pay into the annuity savings fund the amount
7 that he would have paid had he been a member in service
8 during the years that he served as a nursery school teacher.
