RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE EXCISE TAX PROGRAM.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two
2 members of the senate, three members of the house of repre-
3 sentatives, and two persons to be appointed by the governor,
4 one of whom shall be the president of the Association of
5 Massachusetts Assessors or his designee, and the president of
6 the Massachusetts Collectors and Treasurers Association or his
7 designee, is hereby established for the purpose of making an
8 investigation and study relative to the administration of the
9 motor vehicle excise tax program, the reason for the many
10 errors in the nineteen hundred and seventy-one excise tax bills
11 and other matters relative thereto which the commission deems
12 relevant and proper.

In the House of Representatives of the United States of America, at the City of Washington, on the 1st day of January, 1901.

The Government of the Philippines

Approved January 10, 1901.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, January 10, 1901.
