AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION BY THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION OF A PLAYGROUND IN THE ROSLINDALE DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized
- 2 and directed to construct and maintain a playground with
- 3 suitable structures and facilities in the Roslindale district of the
- 4 city of Boston. For said purposes said commission may expend
- 5 such sums as may be appropriated therefor.

The Constitution of the United States

Article I, Section 1, Clause 1

All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States; and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

1. The electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

2. No State shall have less Representatives than the least numerous State, and no State shall have more Representatives than the sum of all the States shall have together.

3. Each Representative shall, when elected, be at least 25 Years of Age, seven Years a Citizen of the United States, and seven Years an Inhabitant of that State in which he shall be chosen.

4. Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.
