AN ACT RELATING TO THE PAYMENT OF BENEFITS UNDER THE PERSONAL INJURY PROTECTION PROVISIONS OF MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY POLICIES AND BONDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 34A of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by chapter 794 of the acts of 1971, is hereby
3 further amended by adding the following paragraph: —

4 Benefits payable to any person under the personal-injury pro-
5 tection provisions of a motor vehicle liability policy or motor
6 vehicle liability bond, as provided for in this section, shall be
7 payable in addition to, and shall not be deducted from, nor shall
8 any credit for such payment be taken against, any payments that
9 may be payable to such person under the provisions of any
10 motor vehicle liability bond as provided in the fifth paragraph
11 above, or under the provisions of any motor vehicle liability
12 policy as provided in the sixth paragraph above, or as provided
13 by any motor vehicle liability bond or motor vehicle liability
14 policy as defined in paragraphs fifth and sixth, respectively, of
15 this section, which affords limits of coverage in excess of five
16 thousand dollars on account of injury to or death of any one
17 person, and, subject to such limits as respects injury to or death
18 of any one person, of ten thousand dollars on account of any one
19 accident resulting in injury to or death of more than one person.
