## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three.

### AN ACT INCREASING THE INTEREST RATE ON UNPAID LOCAL BETTERMENT ASSESSMENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 13 of chapter 80 of the General Laws  
2 is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence, as most  
3 recently amended by chapter 109 of the acts of 1972, and  
4 inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — Assessments  
5 made under this chapter shall bear interest at the rate of six  
6 percent per annum from the thirtieth day after the assessments  
7 have been committed to the collector.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall apply with respect to betterment  
2 assessments made on and after the effective date of this act.
