**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three.

AN ACT INCREASING THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE BARNSTABLE COUNTY HOSPITAL TO ELEVEN MEMBERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 153 of the general acts of 1915 is hereby amended  
2 by striking out section 4, as most recently amended by chapter  
3 72 of the acts of 1922, and inserting in place thereof the  
4 following section: —

5 *Section 4.* The county commissioners shall appoint a board  
6 of eleven persons to acts as trustees of the hospital, three of  
7 whom shall be county commissioners, the county treasurer, the  
8 director of the county health department, three of whom shall  
9 be prominent laymen. Said six members who are physicians  
10 and laymen shall be appointed by the formula of one physician  
11 and one layman from each of three regional areas of the  
12 county. The term of service for the three trustees who are  
13 county commissioners, for the trustee who is the county  
14 treasurer, and for the trustee who is director of the county  
15 health department shall be limited to the duration of time in  
16 which they hold their respective public offices. The remaining  
17 six trustees shall serve in perpetuity, but may have the privilege  
18 of resignation at any time. Resignation may be requested by a  
19 member if, in the opinion of the other members of the board  
20 of trustees, such change is advisable or desirable.
