AN ACT ESTABLISHING A MINIMUM NUMBER OF MEETINGS TO BE HELD BY CERTAIN POLITICAL COMMITTEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any provision of special or general law to
- 2 the contrary, state political committees shall meet at least four
- 3 times in each year; city, ward and town political committees
- 4 shall meet at least twice in each year. The chairman of each
- 5 committee shall inform the state secretary's office of the dates
- 6 of meetings and the number of members in attendance by
- 7 December thirty-first of each year.
