AN ACT REDUCING THE FEE FOR FISHING LICENSES FOR PERSONS OVER SIXTY-FIVE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The second paragraph of section 11 of chapter 131 of the
2 General Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 706 of the
3 acts of 1972, is hereby amended by inserting after the second
4 sentence the following sentence: —

5 One-half the regular fee shall be charged for any fishing license
6 issued under this paragraph to a person over the age of sixty-five.
