AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE MAXIMUM FARE FOR CERTAIN SENIOR CITIZENS ON THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY RAPID TRANSIT LINES SHALL BE FIFTEEN CENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Subsection (e ½) of section 5 of chapter 161A of the  
2 General Laws, inserted by section 1 of chapter 574 of the acts  
3 of 1969, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "fare",  
4 in line 10, the words: — , and provided further that the transit  
5 fare charged such person for transportation on a rapid transit  
6 line shall be fifteen cents.
